

# THE CALVARY CEMETERY ASSOCIATION DAYTON, OHIO

In order to provide a more uniform and uncluttered appearance and to provide for better and more efficient maintenance practices, the following rules and regulations governing memorials are in effect.

## MEMORIAL REGULATIONS

1. All memorials shall be made of granite or bronze.
2. No Slant Face or Bevel markers are allowed.
3. Prepoured concrete monument foundation is not included in the price of the ground.
4. The foundation order, with the appropriate setting charge, **detailed illustration and dimensions** (including any custom epitaph, inscription, picture, etching, statue, or any other symbolism must be submitted to the cemetery office prior to the fabrication of any memorial.
5. All markers and monuments must be registered at the Calvary Cemetery office at the time of delivery.
6. Any marker being delivered by direct shipment, via freight, shall be subjected to a handling fee. Direct shipment via freight of any upright monument is strictly prohibited.
7. The size of monument used is determined by the number and configuration of graves owned on a lot. The minimum and maximum sizes for all monuments are shown on the following pages.
8. Monument lettering of names and dates will be permitted only on side facing graves owned.
9. Calvary Cemetery reserves and shall have the right to correct any error that may be made by its employees, or by any other persons, in the location or placing of a memorial in the cemetery.
10. Calvary Cemetery cannot accept responsibility for any damage to any memorial, structure or decoration on any lot other than through its established direct fault. It is recommended that memorial owners consult their personal insurance agents about possible coverage.

## MARKER RESTRICTIONS

1. One marker is permitted per grave
2. All markers must be set at grass level.
3. **All granite flush markers and granite backers must be at least 4" thick.**
4. **No vases are allowed as part of the marker.** (Excluding Section 47)
5. No inground vases are allowed in Sections 35, 41, 43 & 47
6. Traditional Dedo , PSM, or any other raised profile pictures are not permitted to be mounted on flush markers. However we will allow the flat, low profile type to be used. A recessed area must be provided in the bronze or granite for the photo to be placed.
7. A setting fee will be charged for any existing marker that is being replaced or relocated.
8. The cemetery can provide basic concrete backers for 24 x 12 bronze markers.

The following size restrictions apply to all markers used in Calvary Cemetery.

### Section 19, 38 (Northeast portion)

Flush bronze single (24 x 12) or (24 x 14)

Flush bronze double (min. 36 x 12 – max. 44 x 14)

### Section 45 use:

Flush granite single (min. 24 x 12 x 4 – max. 28 x 16 x 4)

Flush granite double (min. 24 x 12 – max. 48 x 18)

### Section 47 (lawn crypts) use:

See attached rules and regulations

### Section 42 (Infant grave) use:

Flush bronze (16 x 8)

Flush granite (20 x 10)

### Section 10 (Infant grave)

Flush granite (min. 16 x 8 x 4 – max. 20 x 10 x 4)

or Flush bronze (16 x 8)

### Section 22 (Soldier section) use:

Flush bronze veterans marker (24 x 12)

### Section 35 use:

Flush single (24 x 12) – (28 x 18)

Flush double (24 x 12) – (48 x 18)

### All other sections use:

Flush bronze single (24 x 12) or (24 x 14)

Flush bronze double (min. 36 x 12 – max. 44 x 14) Flush

granite single (min. 24 x 12 – max. 28 x 18) Flush granite

double (min. 24 x 12 – max. 48 x 18)

Calvary Cemetery recognizes the importance of maintaining a standard of decorum regarding memorialization in an era of unprecedented personalization and customization options, via graves, laser imagery, glass niches and/or otherwise.

As such Calvary Cemetery maintains the right to regulate and restrict personalization and customization opportunities in all of its offerings in any manner. Calvary is empowered to rectify conduct necessitated by safety, health and/or sanitary concerns as well as anything determined to be controversial, political, offensive, and/or inconsistent with proper and existing decorum at the Cemetery. Inscriptions on memorials must be respectful and free from offensive language. They should celebrate the life and legacy of the departed while being mindful of various religious and cultural sensitivities. Purchasers shall remove and/or otherwise rectify any customization and or personalization at Calvary Cemetery's discretion upon written request from Calvary Cemetery. After fourteen (14) days of issuing written notice, Calvary Cemetery may exercise self-help in executing the removal.

Calvary Cemetery is not and will not be responsible for safe keeping any of the contents and/or property in any of the niches, removed or otherwise. It is not required to keep an inventory or visitors log, and expressly disclaims any obligations to restrict access of key holders/possessor. Calvary Cemetery is not responsible for safeguarding, protecting, and/or retaining property placed in glass niches, including but not limited to, by or for individuals who access same with a key or otherwise. While Calvary Cemetery acknowledges the attractiveness of the customizable nature of its offerings, it is essential for potential purchasers to understand that Calvary Cemetery is in the forever business and strives to maintain a peaceful and cautious standard of neutrality regarding social, political, and/or contentious issues.

Calvary Cemetery will do its best to maintain its existing standards of decorum for purchasers and protect their interests in the same manner we protect those that have gone before us. We appreciate your understanding and collaboration in upholding the sanctity of Calvary Cemetery.
